NOTIFICATION

(Empanelment of Mediators)

In pursuance of the provisions made u/s. 75 of the Consumer Protection Act, 2019, Consumer Protection (Mediation) Rules, 2020 & Consumer Protection (Mediation) Regulations, 2020, to empanel the list of Mediators in the Karnataka State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, the Applications are hereby invited from the suitable candidates who are having the following eligibility criteria.

- (i) Retired Judges of Supreme Court of India;
- (ii) Retired Judges of the High Court;
- (iii) Retired Members of a Consumer Commission;
- (iv) Retired District and Session Judges, retired Additional District and Sessions Judges or other retired Members of the Higher Judicial Services of a State;
- (v) Retired Judicial Officers, having experience of not less than ten years;
- (vi) An Advocate with a minimum experience of ten years at Bar.
- (vii) The Mediators empanelled with the Mediation Cell of the Supreme Court of India, High Court or a District Court;
- (viii) A person having experience of at least five years in mediation or conciliation;
- (ix) Experts or other professionals with at least fifteen years' experience or retired senior bureaucrats or retired executives.

2. As per Regulation 4 of the Consumer Protection (Mediation) Regulations 2020, the candidates who are coming under the following criteria are disqualified for applying for the post of Mediator.

- (i) a person who has been adjudged as insolvent;
- (ii) person against whom criminal charges involving moral turpitude are framed by a criminal court and are pending;
- (iii) a person who has been convicted by a criminal court for any offence involving moral turpitude;
- (iv) a person against whom disciplinary proceedings have been initiated by the appropriate disciplinary authority and are pending or have resulted in a punishment.

3. The fee of Mediators shall be paid as per Regulation 8 of CP (Mediation) Regulations, 2020.

4. The Committee headed by the President & Members of the State Commission will select the suitable candidates to empanel the list of Mediators to conduct the Mediation at the premises of the Karnataka State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission after looking into their suitability with respect to the capacity of resolving the consumer disputes as per C.P. (Mediation) Rules & Regulations.

5. The candidates who are having the above eligibility criteria and who are willfully interested to work as Mediator at the Karnataka State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission shall apply in the prescribed format on or before 15.07.2022 at 5.00 PM to the Registrar-cum-Administrative Officer, Karnataka State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Basava Bhavan, High Grounds, Bengaluru-560001, either in person or through Regd. Post.

7. The Application received after the last date and time will not be considered and the same will be rejected.
